<p>Reading</p> <p>Please read at home daily.</p> <p>Discuss inference questions.</p> <p>Discuss the meaning behind unfamiliar words.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>Rockstars timetables</p> <p>Practise telling the time: o'clock, quarter past, half past, quarter to.</p> <p>Practise column addition and subtractions.</p> <p>Times tables and related division facts for 2, 5, 10 and 3 times tables.</p>	<p>Letter Join</p> <p>Practise using cursive handwriting to form letters.</p> <p>Practise the horizontal and diagonal joins and when these are appropriate to use (see letter join).</p>	<p>Writing</p> <p>Write a newspaper report on the three little wolves.</p> <p>Adding –er and –est to adjectives and using those words in a sentence.</p> <p>Joining two sentences using and, but, so, when.</p> <p>Write a letter to someone to tell them what you have been up to, or what you would like to be doing.</p>
<p>Computing</p> <p>Creating algorithms on Purple Mash.</p>	<p>Geography</p> <p>Revise the countries that make up the United Kingdom.</p> <p>Look at how a key is used on a map to give more information.</p> <p>Discuss the continents that make up the World.</p>	<p>RE</p> <p>Discuss the Jewish religion.</p> <p>Talk about the Jewish holy book and Jewish celebrations.</p>	<p>Phonics</p> <p>Adding a suffix where you need to change the root word: Double the last letter Swap y for i Remove the e</p> <p>Practise phase 5 sounds.</p>
