The Sea



Welcome to Year 2! We hope you have had a great summer and you enjoyed the break, with lots of fun and relaxation. We are looking forward to a really exciting year with lots of interesting things planned.

Our learning this term will be based around our topic of the sea.

In English, we will explore the following texts: Manfish and Dougal's Deep Sea Diary. We will be consolidating our phonic knowledge and will use this to support us when writing a setting description based on Manfish, and writing a fact file about sea creatures in Dougal's Deep Sea Diary.

In Maths we will learning about place value and we will recapping tens and ones in two digit numbers. We will also be ordering two digit numbers and finding ten more and ten less. Towards the end of the term we will be recapping 2D and 3D shapes and their properties.

In Science, we will be looking at Living Things and their Habitats. We will learn about the life processes. We will also be identifying different habitats and thinking about how the animals are adapted to live there.
