Term 3

Anglo-Saxons

If you were an Anglo-Saxon, which would you be?

We hope that you have had a wonderful Christmas break and that you are all rested ready for the new term.

We welcome the children back to Term 3 and straight into the topic of Anglo-Saxons. This term we will learn all about the Anglo-Saxons, where they originated from and how the events of this time affected the history of England.

Music—We will continue learning and developing our skill in recorders - we will be working towards mastering our tunes in preparation for a concert at the end of the year.

In maths we will continue to work on multiplication and division using written methods. Then we will spend some time adding, subtracting and giving change with money. Finally this term, we will begin to look at statistics, presenting and interpreting data.

In RE this term will be looking at the question: Why is the Bible so important for Christians today?

In History and Geography our attentions will be focused around the Anglo-Saxon timeline 400AD to 1066, including what life was like during these times.

In science we will be looking at animals including humans. We will be considering what humans and animals need to stay healthy and how our bodies work.

In English we will be focussing on the epic poem of Beowulf, making posters, writing poems and devising our own new quest for Beowulf. We will also be creating a new monster and writing fact files about it.

In Guided Reading we will continue to master our skills in the following: prediction, inference and deduction, skimming, scanning and retrieval. This will be done through our focus text and other texts based around the Anglo-Saxons.

In Art and DT we will be designing shields and our own Bayeaux Tapestry, making helmets and boats.
