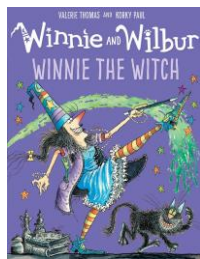
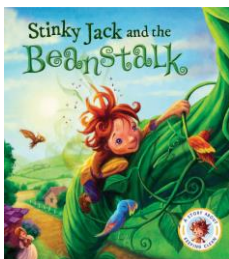


Year 1 Term 6 Newsletter

Welcome to Term 6

Welcome back to the sixth and final term of the school year.! We hope you had a restful half-term break and enjoyed the Jubilee celebrations. We have another busy term coming up and we are looking forward completing Year 1 with some fantastic learning.

Our topic is magic and our texts for the term are linked to this. We will be reading 'Winnie the Witch' by Valerie Thomas and Korky Paul and 'Stinky Jack and the Beanstalk' by Steve Smallman. We are reading these texts to help us create some great writing outcomes. We will be producing both a fiction and non-fiction outcome using some of the skills we have already learned about in Year 1, as well as learning some new writing skills to make our writing meet those Year 1 standards! We have already produced some fantastic pieces of writing this year and we cannot wait to see what the children produce this term.



In Maths this term, we will be beginning to look at multiplication and division. We will look at counting in 2s, 5s and 10s and looking at strategies to help us begin to understanding the process of division. We will then be looking at two measurement units: money and mass/capacity. We will recognise and know the values of the coins and notes we use in the UK. We will then look at mass and capacity of objects and use this to help order them.

In Science, we will be looking at revising all the previous learning we have completed over the school year. We will look at materials, animals and their habitats and plants. This is to make sure our learning has been embedded, ready for more challenging Science in Year 2!

PE kits are to be worn into school on a **Thursday**. Cycling lessons are still taking place on a Thursday, so please bring them in every Thursday unless you are informed otherwise. Our PE learning will be focussed on athletics. Our skills we will look at performance, coaching, fitness and mindset to prepare for our KS1 Sports Day in Term 6.

In Geography, we are going to be locating and naming the four countries of the United Kingdom and naming their capital cities. We are going to be using maps, atlases physically and online to help us with this. We will also be completing some fieldwork activities of our local school area and linking this with previous learning in other topics. In Jigsaw, we will start our Changing Me unit, where will discuss our bodies. In Art, we will be creating some amazing magic salt artwork that we will then create our own Art gallery with, to help us evaluate our own and each other's work.

Thank you for your continued support in reading at home. Please continue to read daily. We will still be continuing our Reading groups in the mornings Tuesday to Friday. Please be aware that some children's groups may change.

We look forward to welcoming you all back for the final term in Year 1! We will be having an Open Evening in Term 6, where you will get to explore our classroom environment and look at your children's progress.
